### New Direct Loan Process Information

Effective summer 2010, NHCC will participate in the William D. Ford Federal Direct Loan program. Under the Direct Loan program students will receive their loan funds directly from the Department of Education rather than a private lender. All students that choose to borrow a loan will need to:

- 1) Complete a 2010-2011 FAFSA and wait to receive an email from NHCC that indicates your award notice is ready to view online. Your online award notice will list your fall and spring loan eligibility.
- 2) Complete a Direct Loan promissory note, and if you are a first time borrower, a loan entrance counseling session. The promissory note and loan entrance counseling session (if needed) is available at [www.studentloans.gov](http://www.studentloans.gov).
- 3) Complete the 'Direct Loan Request 10-11' form and return it to the Financial Aid Office (no faxes).
