

What is the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum?

College students often decide to transfer from one institution to another while completing a degree, and the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities work together to make transferring easier. All 32 state colleges and universities are accredited and offer the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum, a package of general education courses accepted for transfer to the other state colleges and universities.

The Minnesota Transfer Curriculum is a 40-credit package of general education courses that will be accepted for transfer by all of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities.

The University of Minnesota accepts the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum when it is completed in full. Students often complete the transfer curriculum in conjunction with another program.

MnTC Core Goal Areas

To complete the entire MnTC, you must earn a minimum of 40 credits in the ten goal areas, as well as the requirements for each of the goal areas.

- Goal 1: Communication (9-10 credits)
- Goal 2: Critical Thinking (3 credits)
- Goal 3: Natural Sciences (7-8 credits)
- Goal 4: Mathematics/Logical Reasoning (3-5 credits)
- Goal 5: History and the Social and Behavioral Sciences (9-12 credits)
- Goal 6: The Humanities and Fine Arts (9-12 credits)
- Goal 7: Human Diversity (3 credits)
- Goal 8: Global Perspective (3 credits)
- Goal 9: Ethical and Civic Responsibility (3 credits)
- Goal 10: People and the Environment (3 credits)
