- ENGL 1200 Gateway College Writing or ENGL 1200 ENGL 1201 College Writing I
- PSYC 1150 General Psychology or PSYC 1160 Introduction to Psychology
- CHEM 1010 Introduction to Chemistry

*All four must be completed with a grade of C or better and a combined GPA of 2.75 or higher BEFORE submitting your application.

- BIOL 2100 Microbiology
- PSYC 1250 Life Span Developmental Psychology
- COMM 1110 Principles of Interpersonal Communication

**All prerequisite coursework, including Application Prerequisites and Program Prerequisites, must be completed with a grade of C or better and a combined GPA of 2.75 or higher.

Other General Education Courses

- BIOL 2112 Human Anatomy and Physiology II
- SOC 1110 Introduction to Sociology
- PHIL 1020 Ethics or PHIL 1220 Health Care Ethics

These courses are recommended to be taken prior to entering the Nursing Program and must be completed with a C or better.

- Schedule an appointment with your advisor to go over the MANE Holistic Admission criteria

- Once you start the application, you will have 30 minutes to fill it out and submit it

Test Of Essential Academic Skills(TEAS)

TEAS is a timed, multiple choice exam evaluating your knowledge (particularly in areas like the Sciences) including but not limited to: Anatomy and Physiology, Life Science, Chemistry, Math, English and Language Usage, and Reading Comprehension. The exam is computer-based, and the NHCC Testing Center is a MANE testing site

TEAS

- Basic or Developmental TEAS Score <58%
- Proficient TEAS Score 58.7-79.3%
- Advanced TEAS Score 80 91.3%
- Exemplary TEAS Score of 92-100%

All applicants can apply to the program with any TEAS score
