Students will stay in condos at Puerto Aventuras, 15 minutes south of Playa del Carmen in the heart of the Riviera Maya:

- Located on the second largest coral reef in the world, home to thousands of exotic fish and turtle breeding grounds
- Near one of the seven wonders of the world, the Chichen Itza pyramid, as well as the walled city of Tulum and the ruins of Coba
