General Application Information

A complete application includes all of the following:

1. APPLICATION FORM-Submit online

NARRATIVE (up to 500 words) Submit online - The purpose of a narrative is for you to describe to the selection committee why you should be awarded a scholarship. Include the following:

- Your academic goals and how a scholarship will help you attain them
 - The significance a scholarship will make based on your personal situation
 - How you are giving back to the community through volunteer or community service projects
 - Describe any special financial circumstances that you feel would explain your need for a scholarship
- Refer to the scholarship description for any special instructions, including additional narratives.

2. **ADDITIONAL NARRATIVE MAY BE REQUIRED, AS DESCRIBED IN THE SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

Submit to Financial Aid Office

- If you are a current PSEO student, you are not eligible to apply for NHCC scholarships.
- Selection committee and college employees will handle all information about applicants in a professional and confidential manner.

Please note our new process : you do not need to turn in any letters of recommendation or transcripts

Parents and students often think college is going to be more expensive than it really is - especially at the community college level. Tuition at Minnesota State Colleges and Universities is lower than tuition at many other colleges and universities because for every \$1.00 a student pays in tuition, the state pays \$1.07.

There is more financial aid available than ever before - over \$134 billion according to the College Board. Almost \$27 million is given to North Hennepin students each year in the form of grants, scholarships, work-study and loans.

Scholarships

Approximately \$150,000 in scholarships are awarded each year to more than 200 students based on need and merit. Close to 2,000 Scholarships have been awarded since 1995 totaling over \$2.5 million. The average award since 2001 has been \$1,000.

Important information when applying for NHCC Scholarships

- To qualify for and maintain a scholarship, recipient must take a minimum of 6 credits during each applicable semester.
- Application will be submitted online.
- Supporting documents (two letters of recommendation and special narrative) should be turned in at the Financial Aid Office.

Frequently Asked Questions

What types of scholarships are available?
The NHCC Foundation awards approximately 200 scholarships per year to students attending NHCC. Amounts range from \$150 to \$5000 per scholarship. Many different types of scholarships are available to NHCC students.

- Need based scholarships are available to new and returning students showing financial need, regardless of their financial aid status or GPA.
- Merit based scholarships are available to students meeting the specified academic criteria.
- Program based scholarships are available to students enrolled in specific programs at NHCC.

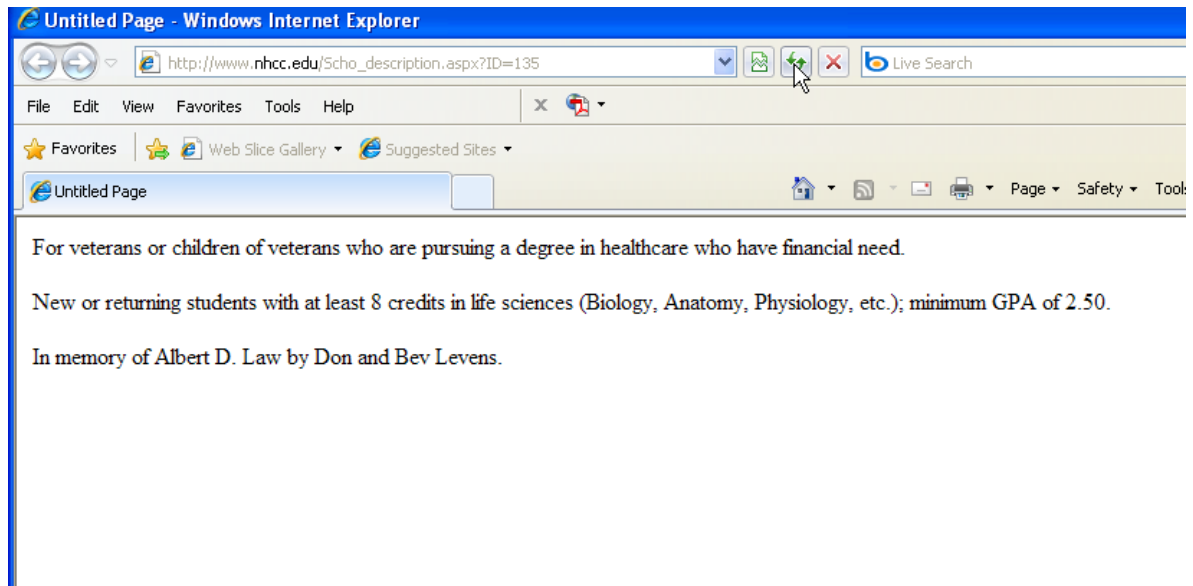

8. After you complete the online application, turn in any additional required information for the scholarship to the financial aid office. When you turn everything in to the Financial Aid Office put your full name and student ID are on the top of the first page.
