## **Award Guidelines:**

### ***PURPOSE***

---

The International Student of the Year Award is intended to recognize and reward the accomplishments and contributions of current F-1/International Students at North Hennepin Community College (NHCC). This award seeks to encourage, identify and recognize the distinctive and extraordinary achievements of F-1/International Students at NHCC.

### ***ELIGIBILITY***

---

All F-1/International Students who:

- Have an active SEVIS record maintained by NHCC
- Are in good academic standing at NHCC
- Have taken courses at NHCC during the Fall 2013 and/or Spring 2014 semester

### ***NOMINATION PROCESS***

---

Follow these steps to submit a nomination:

- Obtain a copy of the “Award Guidelines and Nomination Form” from Scott Johnson, the International Student Advisor (sjohnson@nhcc.edu / 763-424-0892). This form must be used for all nominations.
- Nominate an eligible student for the award. Eligible students may self-nominate or be nominated by someone else in the NHCC community.
- Complete the nomination form. Nominations should provide examples of distinctive and/or extraordinary achievement.
- Send nominations to Scott Johnson **no later than 4:30 pm on Monday, March 31, 2014.**

### ***AWARD RECIPIENTS***

---

The award recipient will:

- Receive an invitation to attend (together with a guest of his/her choice) the 2014 NHCC Student Life Awards ceremony dinner on the evening of Friday, April 25, 2014.
- Receive an award during the recognition ceremony.
- Receive a letter of congratulations from NHCC Interim President, Dr. Lisa Larson.
