

Frequently Asked Questions – “Register for 13 or more credits and 1 will be free!”

Students who register between June 1, 2017 and July 28, 2017 for 13 or more credits at North Hennepin Community College for Fall 2017 will receive a one-credit scholarship applied to their account. Students must be registered no later than 11:59pm on July 28, 2017.

1. Who is eligible?

Students who register for 13 or more NHCC credits during June 1, 2017 – July 28, 2017, except for PSEO students, Concurrent Enrollment students, Consortium students, Partnership students, Visiting students, Law Enforcement CORE (HTC) courses, and students with 12 credits or less.

2. How much is the scholarship credit?

The scholarship is equivalent to one 'residential' credit regardless of course method, academic program or type of credits taken. Students will be responsible for fees attached to any and all credits and books.

3. What if I already registered for 13 credits, prior to June 1, 2017?

NHCC will retroactively add the scholarship credit to all accounts.

4. What if I registered for less than 13 credits, but want to add more?

As long as you are registered for 13 or more credits for Fall 2017 by July 28, 2017, you will be eligible for the scholarship credit.

5. What if I have a hold, but want to register for 13 or more credits?

You must have all holds, balances or issues resolved, and register by July 28, 2017, no exceptions.

6. How will I know if, and when, the scholarship has been applied to my account?

New students will receive a confirmation email by Friday, August 4, 2017. All scholarship credits will be applied by the end of the third week of the term.

7. What happens if I drop my classes or drop below 13 credits after the credit is applied?

The scholarship credit will be removed from your account and a balance will show on your eservices. You will be responsible for payment of that credit.

8. What if financial aid fully covers my tuition, fees, and other costs, will I still get the 1 credit scholarship?

Yes, however, Federal aid regulations limit the total amount of grants, scholarships, loans and/or work study to a student's cost of attendance. If the scholarship creates a situation, where a student's award exceeds the cost of attendance, the student's loan or work-study offer will be reduced. Please contact the Financial Aid Office if you have questions.

9. Will this scholarship credit cover developmental courses?

Yes, as long as you are registered for 13 or more credits for Fall 2017 by July 28, 2017.

10. What is the deadline to receive the scholarship credit for Fall 2017?

You must be registered for 13 or more credits for Fall 2017 by Monday, July 28, 2017 by 11:59pm.
