**No printer-** email [carley.saravia@nhcc.edu](mailto:carley.saravia@nhcc.edu) or [tom.lynch@nhcc.edu](mailto:tom.lynch@nhcc.edu) a brief paragraph along with your address information and tell us why you need a computer. Priority goes to students who have no computer or only have a really outdated computer. We will get this information to Minnesota Computers for Schools on your behalf
