Mission of Mercy The first Minnesota Mission of Mercy was held in Mankato in 2012. The 2015 location will be in Duluth, Minnesota. This is a two-day volunteer event in which free dental services are provided for children, adults and the elderly by volunteer dental professionals.

Smiles Change Lives Provides orthodontic care in private orthodontic offices throughout the state for children ages 10-18 who have a significant malocclusion, can be treated in one stage, have good oral hygiene and cannot afford orthodontic treatment. Applicants need to be below 200% of the federal poverty level. If accepted into the program, the orthodontic treatment fee is \$600. For an application call 888-900-3554.
