Free Online Rapid COVID-19 Tests

This week Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) launched a new program that will enable Minnesotans to <u>order free rapid COVID-19 tests online</u> for delivery directly to their homes. Take advantage of this program and get the free tests before the supply is exhausted.

Even as case numbers decline, it's important that people test for COVID-19 if they are feeling sick. That's why MDH is continuing to make tests easily accessible. The tests can be done at home and results are delivered within minutes, with no lab delivery required. MDH's goal is to ensure that when someone in the community needs a test, they can get one quickly and easily.
