#### After NHCC

The Associate of Science in Nursing is designed to align with the Metropolitan State University BSN degree. All students admitted to the Nursing AS degree will be dually enrolled in North Hennepin Community College and Metropolitan State University. Upon completion of five semesters, graduates are awarded an Associate of Science degree in Nursing and are eligible to apply to take the NCLEXRN exam and meet the Minnesota State Board of Nursing requirements for licensure. NHCC nursing graduates can seamlessly transition to Metropolitan State for an additional 40 credits for the upper division courses to complete their Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN).

## The Nursing Application

The nursing application is currently closed. The next application cycle will open December 1, 2023-February 1, 2024 for a Fall program admission.

#### **Career Outlook**

The Nursing AS degree program prepares graduates to enter the profession of nursing and take the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses. Registered Nurses assess patient health problems. They develop nursing care plans and maintain medical records. They advise patients and provide direct care. They may also provide emotional support to patients and their families.
