<sup>(1)</sup> If an applicant does not have a general biology lab, a more advanced biology lab may be substituted.

Two semesters of combined anatomy and physiology (typically named "Anatomy and Physiology 1" and "Anatomy and Physiology 2"). If A&P is combined into a single-semester course covering the entire body, it must be a minimum of 4 semester credits (lab credits do not count toward the 4 credit minimum). Labs are recommended but not required for anatomy or physiology.

<sup>(2)</sup> Two semesters of human anatomy and physiology are generally required, in one of two formats: One anatomy course and one physiology course

<sup>(3)</sup> The social and behavioral science, advanced composition, and communication requirements will be considered fulfilled for applicants who will have completed a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited U.S. institution prior to beginning the PharmD program. Applicants without a bachelor's degree must fulfill the social and behavioral science, advanced composition, and communication requirements as listed. A final official transcript will be required. For applicants with a degree, we reserve the right to verify that their non-math and non-science coursework is sufficient.

<sup>(4)</sup> Advanced composition (writing) course generally requires an introductory composition course as a prerequisite. Course must be taken in English; may not be fulfilled with an English as a Second Language course.

<sup>(5)</sup> Approved communication courses include Introduction to Communication, Public Speaking, Interpersonal Communication, Intercultural Communication, Organizational or Business Communication, and Group Communication. Media communication courses do not fulfill this prerequisite.
