## **Helpful Hints**

ENGL 1202 College Writing II (2 credits) is HIGHLY recommended in order to be successful in the nursing program.

**Semester 2:** Three science classes with labs are a challenge to take at one time

Semester 3: Recommended to take ENGL 1202

It is recommended that the COMM and PSYC elective courses be taken prior to the start of the nursing program courses, if possible:

**COMM Electives:** 1110, 1210, COMM 1810

**PSYC Electives:** 1150, 1250, PSYC 1160

This schedule is intense. Consider taking 1 or 2 classes during the summer (COMM and PSYC electives).

The Nursing program has a Fall and Spring admission each year (see the website for deadlines, <a href="www.nhcc.edu/nursing">www.nhcc.edu/nursing</a>) and there is a separate application to apply.

All nursing program courses in semesters 3-5 must be successfully completed in order to move on to the next semester.

**Transfer Students:** Meet with an Advisor to appeal and waive BIOL 1001 if Anatomy and Physiology 1 and Microbiology is completed.
