The Nursing program has a Fall and Spring admission each year (see the website for deadlines, www.nhcc.edu/nursing) and there is a separate application to apply.




Tier 1 prerequisite courses ([◇]) must be completed prior to applying to the nursing program and completed with a C or better and 2.75 GPA or higher.

Tier 2 prerequisite courses (^{◇◇}) must be completed prior to starting in the NURS program courses completed with a C or better and 2.50 GPA or higher-.

All nursing program courses in semesters 3-5 must be successfully completed in order to move on to the next semester.

Transfer Students: Meet with an Advisor to appeal and waive BIOL 1001 if Anatomy and Physiology 1 and Microbiology is completed.
