The Nursing program has a Fall and Spring admission each year (see the website for deadlines, www.nhcc.edu/nursing) and there is a separate application to apply.

Tier 2 prerequisite courses (◇◇) must be completed prior to starting in the NURS program courses completed with a C or better and 2.50 GPA or higher+.
