Apply for Admission: 763-424-0724

Complete an NHCC Application for Admission available at www.nhcc.edu/admissions. You will receive your Student/Tech ID after your application has been processed. If you have attended NHCC in the past, complete the Student Record Update Form available at www.nhcc.edu/forms.

Submit All (Including Military) Transcripts: veterans@nhcc.edu

Your military training may count for credit toward your degree. See <https://www.nhcc.edu/student-resources/veterans-affairs> then click on “Credit for Military Training” on the left.

- Request an official transcript from all other colleges you have attended
- Submit transcripts to Admissions and Registration

Make Satisfactory Payment Arrangements: 763-424-0718

Students with Veterans benefit request Form on file will have tuition deferred while VA processing occurs. You may pay your tuition and fees with cash, check, credit card or the payment plan. Make sure to make payment arrangements by the payment due dates at www.nhcc.edu/dates to avoid having your registration canceled. Note: Invoices for tuition are not mailed. GI benefits under Chapters 30, 31, 33, 1606, or 35 will have tuition automatically deferred, while they are waiting GI Bill payments. FTA must turn in authorization form from goarmyed in order to be deferred. Deferring tuition will hold your courses without having to set up a payment plan.
