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5 general tips for essays...

- Don't compose in the application form (open a Word doc, copy/paste later)
- Ignore word counts at first just tell your story! We can trim it down in revision.
- Who says you have to write these 3 essays in order? Start where you are comfortable.
- Tell your story in your own voice. They want to see YOU! (Avoid the trap of "I need to sound smart here.")
- Answer the question! Notice key words and phrases (such as "commitment and drive" and "how this inspires you to become a nurse"). This helps you ensure that you are answering the question, and they can give clues for structuring your answer!





Lived Experience

250 words or less (Do not include your name in your essay)

Describe your personal lived experiences outside of work and educational experiences. Include how this inspires you to become a nurse and what this teaches you about the commitment and drive it takes to be a successful and committed nurse.


