

## STUDENT SENATE ELECTION CAMPAIGN GUIDELINES

1. Candidates may not begin campaigning until **Tuesday, March 24 at 12:00 pm** and eligibility has been confirmed.
2. Candidates are responsible for familiarizing themselves with and following all relevant NHCC, Student Life, and Student Senate policies (i.e. Senate Constitution). This includes the Code of Conduct.
3. If candidates would like to hang posters/flyers, the campus policy must be followed, which includes up to 10 flyers and approval by the Office of Student Life; materials will be hung around campus in designated areas by OSL staff.
4. If candidates would like to reserve a table in the Campus Center, please contact Student Life at [studentlife@nhcc.edu](mailto:studentlife@nhcc.edu) or come see Tarsha Davis-Martin in Student Life to schedule this.
5. While polls are open, **no campaigning may take place by approaching students at computers on campus. This includes using tablets and mobile devices to encourage others to vote.**
6. Libel and slanderous campaigning are not permitted.
7. No person may personally or through an agent intimidate, harass, use or threaten the use of force, violence, or restraint in order to compel or induce any person to vote or abstain from voting for a particular candidate.
8. All campaigns must be financed at the expense of the student. No College and/or Student Life resources or fees may be used for campaigning purposes.
9. **Campaigning must end at 11:59 pm on the last day of the election (Thursday, April 2nd), when online polls close.**

***Failure to comply with these guidelines may result in removal from the election.***
