#### **Description:**

The Student Ambassador program is a leadership opportunity for students who are dedicated to serving and representing North Hennepin Community College. Student Ambassadors provide campus tours, serve as an NHCC representative and perform duties at various North Hennepin Community College campus and community events. Student Ambassadors also serve at the Information Center where they act as a first point of contact to visitors, both by phone and in person.

We are currently looking for Student Ambassadors who want to serve in one, or both, of the following roles: More detailed list of responsibilities on reverse.

- All-Around Ambassadors:
  - Work regular weekly hours assisting at the Admissions & Outreach Information Center welcoming public, managing phones and calendars, and assisting with various tasks related to events.
  - o Serve as a knowledgeable first point of contact for guests to North Hennepin Community College
  - o Conduct tours of North Hennepin Community College
  - o Represent NHCC during college and community events
- Special Events Ambassadors:
  - Represent NHCC during college events such as Fast Track, Open House, and College Knowledge Month visit program
  - Conduct special visit campus tours for new students, schools, classes, new/prospective employees and guests
  - Sit on student panels for events.

#### **Hours:**

- Required Staff Trainings will vary
- Up to 15 hours per week, Office open M, Th, F: 7:30am-4:30pm, T-W: 7:30am-6:30pm
- Various hours representing North Hennepin Community College at campus and community events.
- Depending on Student Ambassador role, evening and weekend hours may be expected.

Schedules are determined based on your course schedule and current Student Ambassador staffing.

### **Responsibilities of All-Around Ambassadors:**

- Welcome and greet public at Admissions & Outreach Information Center
- Perform clerical duties and office responsibilities
- Provide various services and referrals to the campus
- Develop an expanded knowledge of North Hennepin Community College
- Conduct campus tours for new students, schools, classes, and guests
- Represent North Hennepin Community College during college events
- Assist with duties and tasks related to events put on by various North Hennepin Community College departments
- Work with diverse populations and exhibit the attributes of a successful student
- Learn and have a working knowledge of service area equipment such as computers, copiers, printers and more
- Assist students with general technical questions such as StarID retrieval, password reset, eServices use, student email and community use computer/printer stations
- Maintain work space appearance and professionalism
- Possess a willingness to work with groups in problem solving and decision-making to attain group goals and objectives
- Participate in mandatory Ambassador Team trainings
- All other duties as assigned

#### **Responsibilities of Special Events Ambassadors:**

- Assist with set-up and clean-up related to special recruitment events on campus such as Fast Track in July and December, Open House in April and College Knowledge Month in October
- Exhibit interpersonal and public speaking skills by representing North Hennepin Community College at special events in various ways which may include, but are not limited to, the following:
  - Lead tours of NHCC
  - Greet guests
  - o Assist with check-in
  - o Help students register for classes
  - Answer general questions about the event, school and admissions/enrollment processes
- Participate in student panels for groups visiting campus

#### **Qualifications:**

- Must be a currently enrolled North Hennepin Community College student
- Must be currently enrolled in at least 6 credits and be financial aid eligible
- Must maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5
- Demonstrate strong communication (written and verbal) and interpersonal skills
- Exhibit leadership, initiative, dependability, discipline, enthusiasm and willingness to grow both personally and professionally
- Must be able to effectively lead campus tours, including leading consecutive tours and during all weather conditions
- All Ambassadors will remain in probationary status for the first 30 days.
